Big Time Blue Lavender you can expect armloads of heady scented, deep purple-blue blossoms, excellent for fresh and dried bouquets. The gray-green foliage forms a nice shape when mature making it ideal for edging. It works well as a low hedge or for mass plantings. Big Time Blue has proven to grow well in our hot, humid summers. Deer and bunny resistant, and repels mosquitoes

Plant Lavender in full sun to part shade in well-drained soil. Good drainage is a must for Lavender.

Cut spent flowers to encourage more blooms.

Plants benefit from a light pruning in early spring
