Oregano Greek

Origanum vulgare hirtum

PERENNIAL growing to 0.6 m (2ft) by 0.6 m (2ft in).

It is hardy to zone 5 and is not frost tender. It is in flower from Jul to September, and the seeds ripen from Aug to October. It is noted for attracting wildlife.

Suitable for: light (sandy),

medium (loamy) and heavy (clay)

soils, prefers well-drained soil and can grow in nutritionally poor soil. It prefers dry or moist soil. The plant can tolerate strong winds but not maritime exposure.
